



A STABLE, GROWING MARKET

Nanotechnology, higher education, healthcare, government and tourism continue to drive the Albany economy.

- As the state capital, government provides a stable economic base with nearly 103,000 local jobs and an annual payroll of \$15 billion
- New York State lobbying creates an annual economic impact of approximately \$3 million on the Capital Region when legislature is in session (Jan-June)
- The Capital Region healthcare field provides over 70,000 local jobs with an average annual payroll of \$4.5 billion. Local hospitals generate \$4 billion each year in economic activity.














NANOTECHNOLOGY ALBANY

MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS

SUNY Polytechnic Institute

- Formerly the College of Nanoscale Science & Engineering, located .5 miles from Crossgates
- 1.65 million sq ft, \$24 billion facility; Over 4,000 scientists and high-tech workers
- First college in the world dedicated to research, development and education in Nanoscience
- SUNY Poly represents the world's most advanced university-driven research enterprise with more than 300 global corporate partners
- Intel Corp. and IBM will collaborate on next-generation semiconductor research in a new initiative to be based in Albany. The collaboration would bring hundreds of jobs to the area.
- Construction of 50,000 sq. ft. of new cleanroom space, located south of the existing NanoFabX cleanroom building. Multiple semiconductor-related tenants are anticipated to occupy the building. A new four-level covered parking structure with 400 spaces, including 30 spots for electric vehicles will also be constructed.

GlobalFoundries

- \$15 billion, 1.3 million sq. ft. semiconductor manufacturing facility
- 3,000 people employed; local payroll exceeding \$338 million
- Plans are underway to build a second semiconductor fabrication plant at its Fab 8 campus. Will add 737,000 sq. ft. across nine buildings, create 1,000 jobs and will double its manufacturing capacity to address the worldwide chip shortage.
- GF is under contract to purchase 800 acres at the Luther Forest Campus, a move that would give the
 computer chip maker control of one of the largest remaining pieces of undeveloped commercial property in the
 Albany region. Will purchase the property if and when the federal government approves roughly \$52 billion in
 funding to entice companies to produce more computer chips in the U.S. The estimated total investment will
 be between \$6 and \$8 billion.

General Electric


- Located just 11 miles west of Crossgates employing over 6,000 people; \$400 million invested
- Recent studies have shown that GE is worth \$4 billion a year to the Capital Region; each day generates \$10.9 million, and each hour generates more than \$458,000

Emerging Technology and Entrepreneurship Complex (E-TEC)

• The 12-acre, \$184 million E-TEC will house the new College of Emergency Preparedness, Homeland Security and Cybersecurity, State Police, and will be the hub of the New York State Mesonet. This new complex will help keep New York on the cutting edge of technological innovation, as well as help ensure we are prepared for emerging threats, such as extreme weather and terrorism.

Wadsworth Center

- New York State has included \$750 million in its final budget to build a new hub for the Wadsworth
 Center, the state's public health lab. New 750,000 sf lab could create more than 1,200 new life
 sciences jobs and generate \$2.3 billion in economic activity in the region if the state partners with
 private companies.
- Construction of the lab would require 2.3 million trades hours, the equivalent of 590 union jobs



HIGHER EDUCATION


The Capital Region includes 20 colleges and universities with over 71,000 students and a combined economic impact of nearly \$4.4 billion.

The Capital Region is home to some of the most highly ranked higher education institutions in the United States according to US News & World Report.









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
CAPITAL REGION TOURISM

Tourism generated over \$1.9 billion in visitor spending and \$1.1 billion in labor income in 2021.

The Capital Region sees 200,000 Canadian visitors annually with \$60 million in direct spending.

Top area attractions include:

- Saratoga Race Course attendance in 2021 was over 1 million
- Times Union Center The 17,500 capacity arena with 539,000 visitors annually
- Saratoga Performing Arts Center (SPAC) over 360,000 visitors annually
- New York State Capitol Building
- Adirondack Park Over 14 million people one of the largest parks in the U.S. (larger than Yosemite, Yellowstone, Glacier, Grand Canyon and the Great Smokey Mountains National Parks combined)











BEST PLACE TO LIVE IN NY!

US News & World Report has named Albany, NY the Best Place to Live in New York and #45 in the country due to better value for housing, healthy job market and low unemployment.

- · There has been significant housing growth over the past five years due to the growth in the medical, technology, government and education sectors as well as the migration of New York City residents to upstate locations following the pandemic.
- Realtors report that new home buyers have high disposable income but don't have time to travel resulting in more local spending.
- The 2021 Albany-Saratoga housing market is booming with the median sale price up 9.2%, number of home sold up 57% and median days on market down 74.1% to only 8 days!








AREA LODGING

Over 8,550 hotel rooms surround Crossgates within a 10 mile radius.

- In the past 2 years, close to 1,000 more hotel rooms were added or in the approval process
- \$457 million was spent on lodging by travelers to the Capital-Saratoga Region in the last year
- Hotel occupancy rates in Albany are consistently at 60% or higher
- Crossgates is well positioned to capture all of the downtown and hotel traffic off of the thruway
